ScamWatch

Scams twice in the last month someone has tried to scam payments on my ISP internet account.

I get an auto generated bill from my ISP. The scammers have tried to duplicate it.

Close but not close enough.

My ISP just told me to delete. With the second I went direct to the [ScamWatch](#) site. Filled out form and uploaded both files of the scams. Important to note you can't upload an email. You must first convert to a "text" or "Photo" file, PDF is best option.

The easiest way to create that sort of file is to print to a PDF printer. A small program called CuteWriter converts the file to PDF and allows you to then upload to [ScamWatch](#).
